10A	43.16 %	Household care – excluding aerosol/spray – products
10B	100.00 %	Household aerosol/spray products
11A	2.46 %	Products with intended skin contact but minimal fragrance transfer to skin from inert substrate without UV exposure
11B	2.46 %	Products with intended skin contact but minimal fragrance transfer to skin from inert substrate with potential UV exposure
12	100 %	Products not intended for direct skin contact, minimal or insignificant transfer to skin
